The Perisphere Theater board of directors is composed of leaders from the nonprofit and for-profit sector who are dedicated to the company's mission of producing exemplary theater in the greater Washington, D.C., area.

Serving on the Perisphere board of directors is an opportunity for enthusiastic, engaged individuals who are passionate about building a new theater company (founded in 2015) that presents artistic excellence and is supported by sound business practices, creative educational outreach, successful fundraising strategies, and solid leadership.

Nonprofit arts organizations need a strong and effective board to fully realize their potential in both artistic ventures and community outreach. Joining a founding board of a new company provides a chance for members to participate in the exciting stages of launching a new arts "face" in the region and building its reputation. In addition to the standard roles and responsibilities of a board member, Perisphere Theater's board members will be advocates and ambassadors for the organization as well as being engaged in identifying and securing the financial resources and partnerships necessary for the company to advance its mission.

Areas of Expertise

We are currently recruiting for a diverse group of leaders with expertise in any of the following areas:

- Experience in the nonprofit world, with knowledge of successful strategies and structuring for an arts organization in a major metro area.
- Experience in the corporate world, with knowledge of business best practices, organization of resources, and how to build and sustain a healthy company.
- Experience in development, fundraising, grant writing, and executing successful strategies for both the short- and long-term financial health of a nonprofit.

Individual Board Member Responsibilities

- Board members are expected to attend two to three in-person board meetings per year, as well as respond to necessary action items over email or phone. They will read board materials in advance of board meetings and come prepared to ask questions and participate in discussions.
- Board members will serve a two-year term, and will be eligible for re-appointment for at least one additional term.
- Board members are expected to serve on one or more committees of the board, if committees are formed, and to actively participate in committee work.

- Board members will play an active role in securing the financial resources necessary for Perisphere to achieve its mission. Board members are expected to leverage personal relationships and connections to help the development committee and staff identify and solicit potential funders, as well as directly invest in the company's work by making a personal contribution each year.
- Board members will responsibly represent Perisphere Theater to their respective communities and are expected to advocate for its mission, programs, and services as appropriate.
